

Installing MeadCo Printing Script

1. Open a new internet explorer window, and navigate to google.com
2. In the search box type in MeadCo Script X and press enter.
3. The first link that appears should be scriptx.meadroid.com and should state **MeasCo's ScriptX** in the title (as shown) and click on the Link

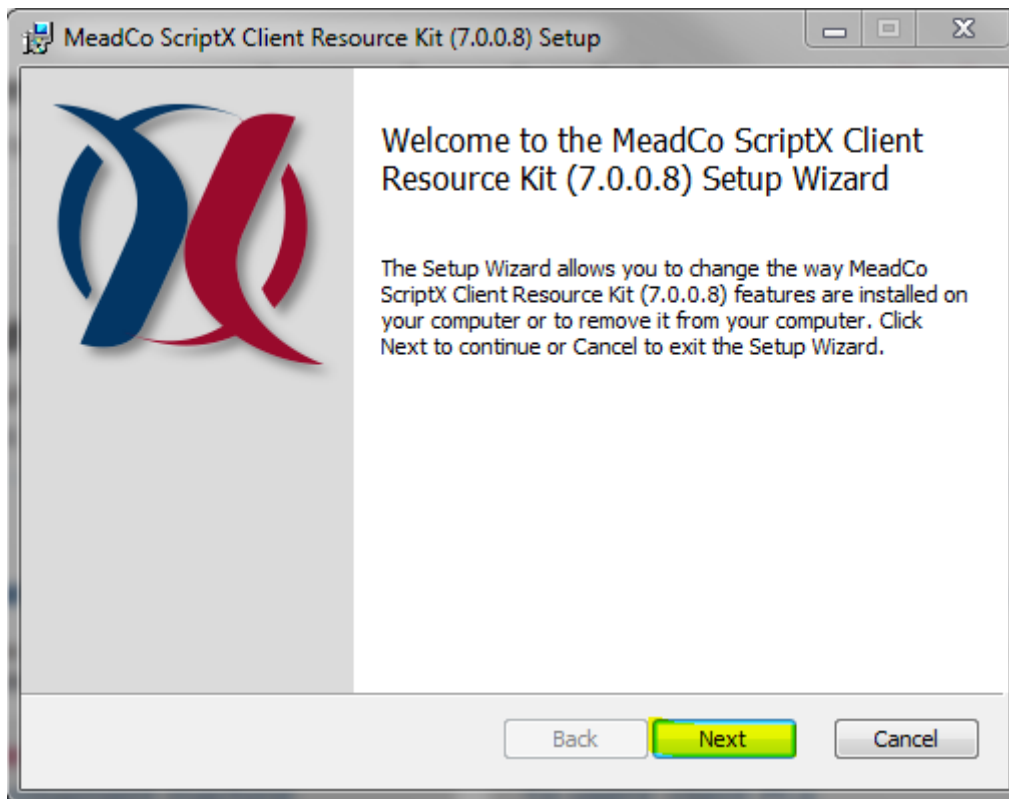
I've downloaded the ScriptX Client Resource Kit, now what?

First, install the Client Resource Kit. This will **copy** the freely re-distributable binary components into a folder on your machine and a 'readme' file to get you started. The ScriptX software will **not** be installed ... see below for what to do next:

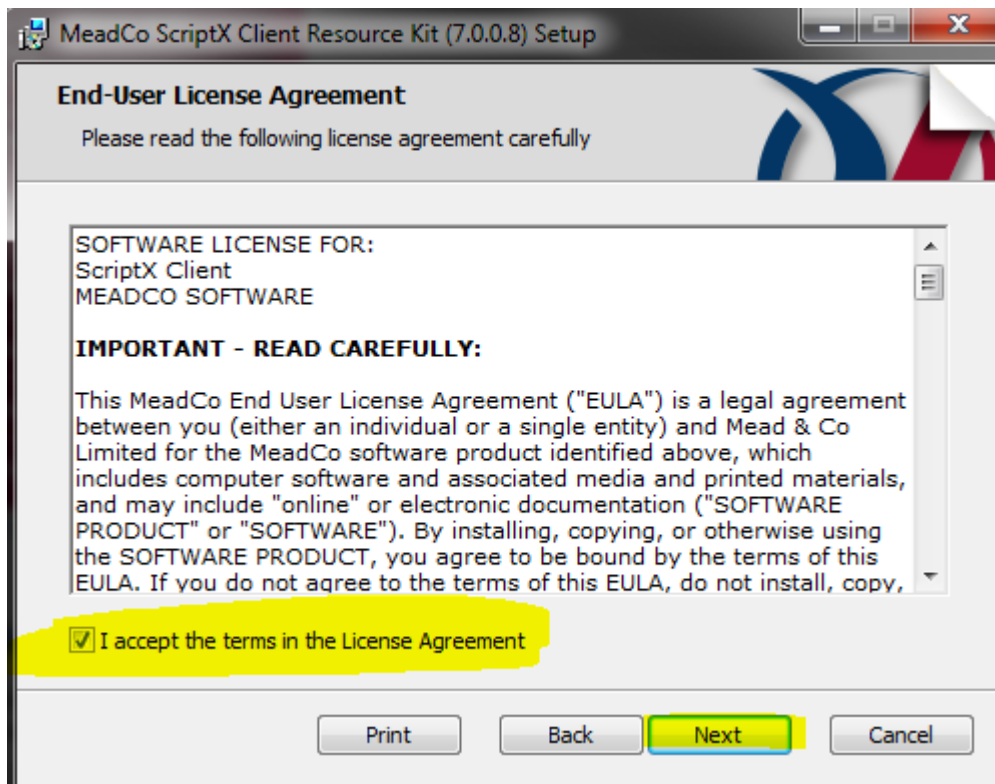
6. Once the download starts you will get one variation of these box that says Run, Save or Cancel. Click **Run**.



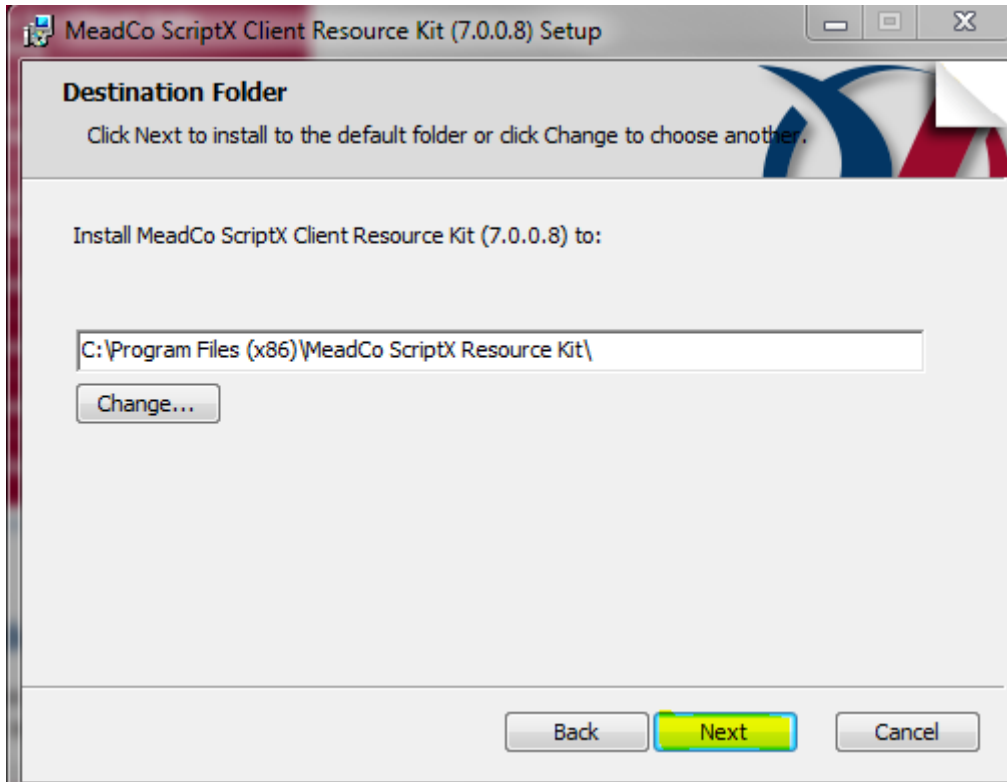
7. After clicking run you will see the welcome to MeadCo ScriptX Box. Select **Next**.



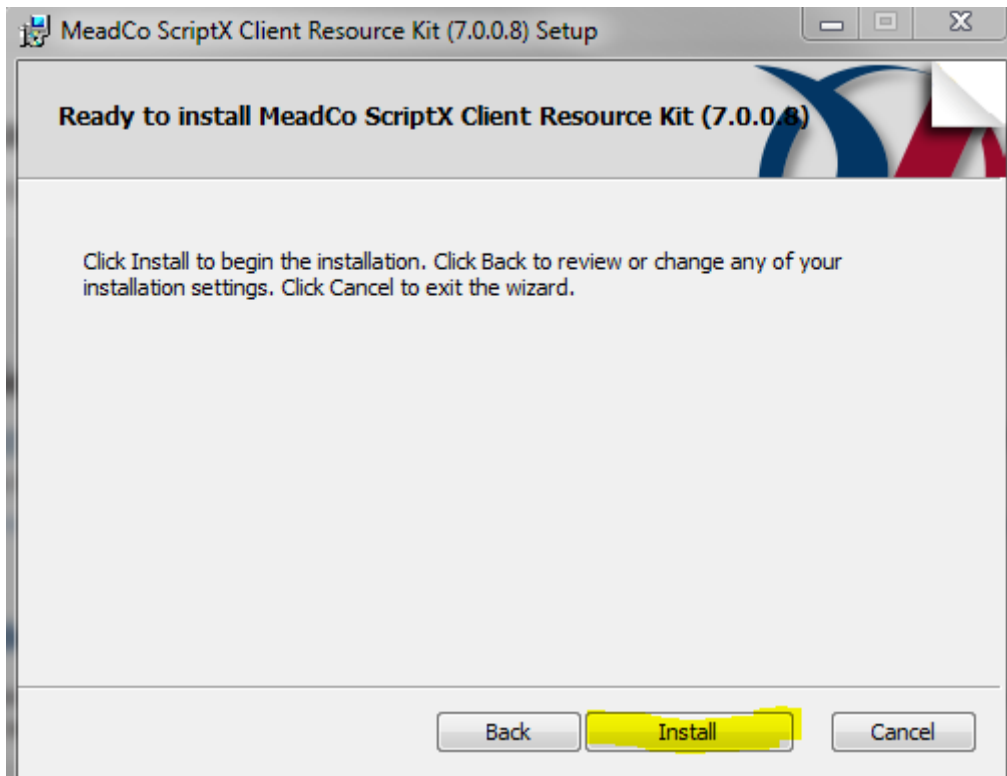
8. Next you will need to **Check** the "I accept to Terms and Agreement" and then select **next**.



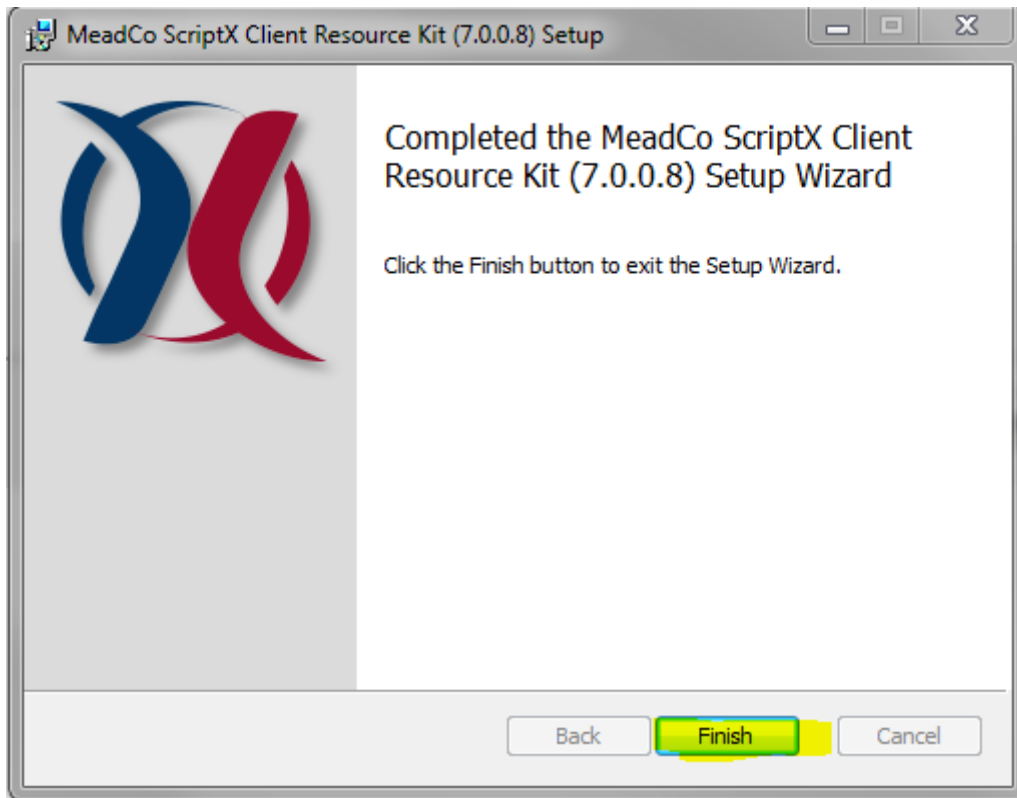
9. On the destination folder page just select **Next**.



10. On the ready to install page Click **Install**



11. After clicking **Install** the installer will complete itself and you will just need to click **Finish** when it is installed.



12. You have completed the install of MeadCo ScriptX!
